TEACHERS PROGRAMS OF SEAMEO INNOTECH**

1. Pursuant to Regional Advisory dated August 3, 2016 Re: TEACHeXCELS FOR SCHOOL HEADS AND GURO21 FOR MASTER TEACHERS PROGRAMS OF SEAMEO INNOTECH and in reference to DepEd Memo No. 413, s. 2009 and DepEd Memo No. 18, s. 2012, this Office hereby informs interested applicants for a continuing education and training in advanced tasks through competency-based, multi-modal, modularized flexible learning courses that utilize the web-based learning management platform known as the INNOTECH Learning Management System or IFLEX, to wit:
 - a. TEACHeXCELS (Teaching-Learning Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia) for School Heads
 - b. GURO21 (Facilitating the Development of 21st Century Skills for Southeast Asian Teachers) for Master Teachers
2. Each of the courses may be creditable with at least three (3) academic units for an appropriate graduate/post-graduate degree program from any of the sixteen (16) accredited teacher education institutions in the Philippines. SEAMEO INNOTECH's partnership agreements with such institutions provide that the graduates are certified by SEAMEO INNOTECH as having acquired certain prescribed competencies.
3. The Division Office may use local funds for the enrolment of elementary and/or secondary school heads and master teachers to the respective course subject to the usual existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations/procedures.





4. The Division is given the slots of seven (7) participants for the School Heads Category (TEACHeXCELS) and three (3) participants for the Master Teachers Category (GURO21). Hence, this Office advises interested applicants to coordinate to the SEPS-HRDS c/o Margie R. Valmoria for confirmation of participation as soon as possible.

1. In reference to DepEd Memo no. 413, s.2009 and DepEd Memo no.18, s. 2012 re: Excellence in School Leadership Program of SEAMEO INNOTECH and through the initiative of the Region, the following SEAMEO INNOTECH Courses are offered to provide school heads and master teachers with opportunities for continuing education and training in advanced tasks through competency-based, multi-modal, modularized flexible learning courses that utilize the web-based learning management platform known as the INNOTECH Learning Management System or IFLEX, to wit:
 - a. **TEACHxCELS (Teaching-Learning Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia) for School Heads** is a two-module, four-week on-line learning short course designed to enhance the instructional leadership skills of school heads in managing and supporting the teaching-learning processes in schools; and,
 - b. **GURO21 (Facilitating the Development of 21st Century Skills for Southeast Asian Teachers) for Master Teachers** aims to develop and enhance the master teachers' facilitating skills for them to effectively play their role as teachers in the 21st century. The course equips the teachers with knowledge, skills, attitudes, and values (KSAVs) essential for them to meet the challenges and demands of the 21st century. By enrolling in the course, teachers will develop professional and personal readiness as a 21st century teacher so that, in turn, they will be able to help their students become 21st century-ready themselves.
2. Each of the courses may be creditable with at least three (3) academic units for an appropriate graduate/post-graduate degree program from any of the sixteen (16) accredited teacher education institutions in the Philippines. SEAMEO INNOTECH's

partnership agreements with such institutions provide that the graduates are certified by SEAMEO INNOTECH as having acquired certain prescribed competencies.

3. The Division Office may use local funds for the enrolment of elementary and/or secondary school heads and master teachers to the respective course subject to the usual existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations/procedures.
