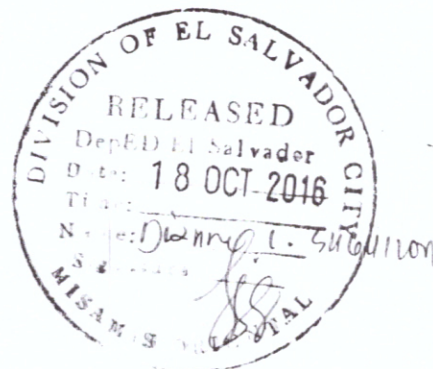

Special Awards Guidelines

A. BEST IN PARADE AND MARCHING SALUDO MECHANICS

1. The contest is open to all schools//district participating in the parade during Opening Ceremonies of the City Meet.
2. Each team should render a progressive salute in marching cadence at the designated starting point and execute saludo as they pass the VIP area of the main grandstand. A Minimum of 3 and a maximum of 6 minutes including entrance and exit. Violation of this rule shall merit disqualification from the contest.
3. One (1) from the elementary and one (1) from the secondary level who will have the best execution.
4. Criteria for judging:

Uniformity of Marching Movements	40%
Saludo Execution	40%
Artistic Visual Effects	<u>20%</u>
TOTAL	100%

B. MOST DISCIPLINED DELEGATION MECHANICS

1. The contest is open to all participating teams joining the opening parade.
2. The top two (2) in the elementary and the secondary level displaying the most order in column formation and being the most behaved in mobilizing from the parade assembly area to the designated ground venue assembly area during the opening parade .
3. Criteria for judging:

Behavior	50%
Order	<u>50%</u>
TOTAL	100%

C. BIGGEST DELEGATION MECHANICS

1. The number of delegation is based on the following:

For the elementary Level:

More or less 100 athletes

For secondary level:

More or less 125 athletes

2. Number of teachers (non-coach/ or non-/official) who will join the opening parade. Unit chairpersons are required to submit the total number of teachers in your district and indicate WILL JOIN OR WILL NOT JOIN and state the reason.
3. One (1) from the elementary and one (1) from the secondary level will be awarded.
4. Barangay officials and PTA officials are included in the counting.

D. CLEANEST AND ORGANIZED QUARTER

1. Rating scale of the cleanest and organized quarter are as follows:


5 – Best 4 – Better 3 – Good 2 – Fair 1 – Poor

2. Monitoring team will rate based on the following:

- A. Reception booth/area
- B. Information board containing all necessary information about the Activities, etc.
- C. Organizing box containing all documents/information of athletes, coaches, working committee, etc.
- D. Organized, clean and well-arranged mess hall
- E. Organized, clean and well-arranged kitchen.
- F. Area signage
- G. Organized, clean and well-arranged quarters for athletes

- E. The decision of the board of judges is FINAL.
