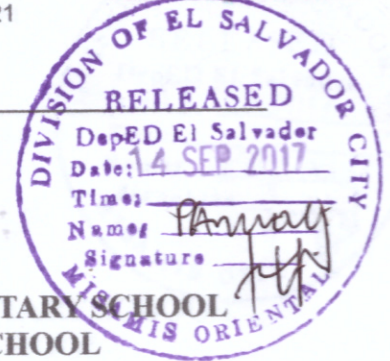

Greetings of Peace!

A urine test strip or dipstick test is a basic diagnostic tool used to determine pathological changes in a patient's urine in standard urinalysis. Once a urine sample is collected, a nurse or technician will place a specially treated chemical strip (dipstick) into your child's urine (pee).

The results of a urine dipstick test may point to a diagnosis of urinary tract infection (UTI), kidney disease, diabetes, or a urinary tract injury. If test results are abnormal, other tests will be needed before a definite diagnosis can be made.

In line with this, the City Health Office of El Salvador City will conduct a Urine Dipstick Test among the Grade 1 students of selected public elementary schools of El Salvador City this September 2017. The respective school will be given schedule date and time for the said activity.
