Date: September 6, 2017

1. This is to inform the field of the **Regional Celebration of 2017 World Teachers' Day** on **October 6, 2017** at **Limketkai Atrium, Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City**.
2. The celebration aims to:
 - a. honor those who are in the teaching profession;
 - b. acknowledge and give emphasis on the crucial role, loyal service, and dedicated commitment of teachers in developing globally-minded citizens, nurturing families, strengthening communities, and building the nation;
 - c. revitalize the image of and respect for teaching as a vocation by increasing public awareness on the value of teachers in the Philippines society;
 - d. take the occasion as an opportunity in building the image of teaching as an attractive and fulfilling profession;
 - e. generate widespread support and assistance for teachers; and
 - f. express gratitude for the positive influences of teachers on Filipino learners.

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3. The celebration includes the following activities:
 - a. Awarding of Winners for the following events:
 - i. Search for Outstanding Teacher (I, II and III) and Master Teacher (I and II) for both public and elementary and junior high school levels, ALS Teacher, Mobile Teacher, Multi-grade Teacher, Kindergarten Teacher, Special Education Teacher;
 - ii. Search for 2017 Ambassador and Ambassadors of Education;
 - iii. Dugong Guro Best Implementers; and
 - iv. Barkada Kontra Droga.
 - b. Showdown of traditional dances around the world presentation and raffling of prizes.
4. Enclosed with this Memorandum is the distribution of the number of participants per school.
5. Meals of the participants shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. On the other hand, transportation expenses may be charged to local funds, depending on the available funds of the schools.

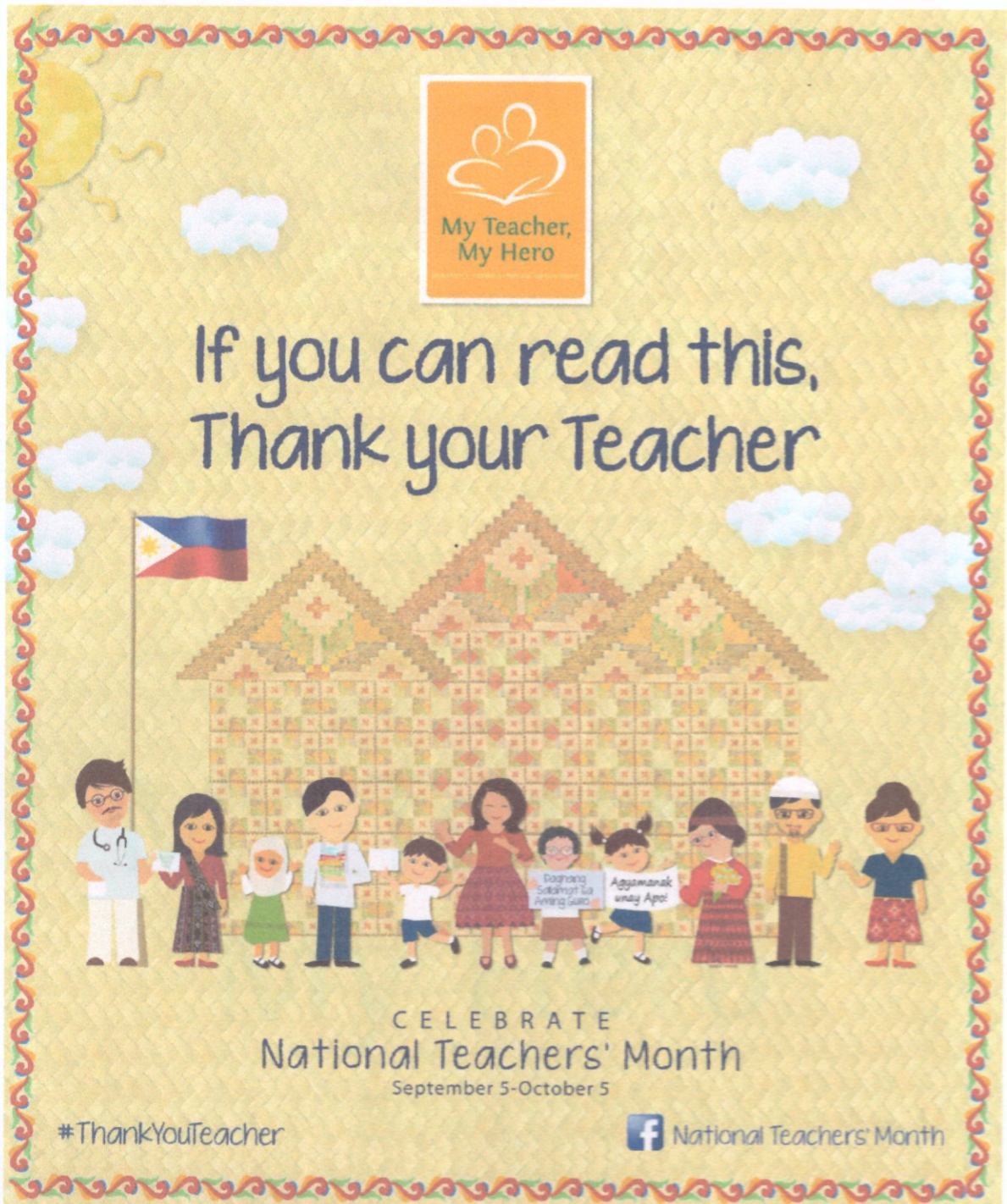
