

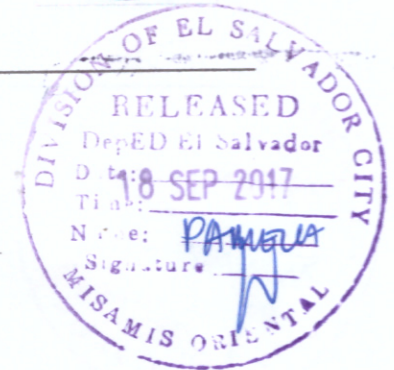

2. This undertaking aims to provide mutual benefits between the delinquent real property tax owners and the City Government, in a way it gives tax relief to the former, while the later can generate more income through massive payments of delinquent real property taxes.


