

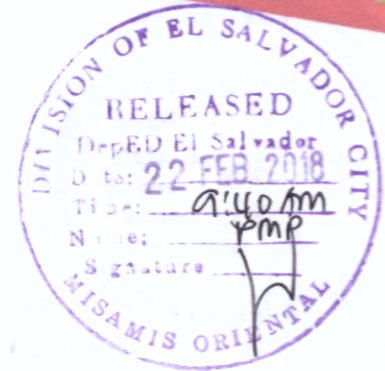

It is the movement's main goal to provide program opportunities to develop their potential and to become the leaders of their generation and of the future.

Please find below the details of the said regional event, to wit:

> **Dates and Place of the Encampment:** April 10-15, 2018
Mangima SpringResort
Manolo Fortich, Bukidnon

>Theme: "Leading the Change, Living the Change"

> **Registration Fee:** P 2,500 per camper
(to cover food, camp souvenirs, fare during offsite adventures, entrance & selected rides @ Dahilayan Forest Park program and required activity materials, Charged to Local School Board/MOEE Funds, subject to the usual auditing and accounting procedures.

Special package for the Optional Activities during the offsite adventures will be sent as soon as the host council will finalize their rate. Optional activities fee will be shouldered by the interested campers.

> **Participants:** Junior, Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts with Adult Chaperon (Troop Leaders)
Minimum of 50 delegates per council, but no limit to the maximum.

> **Qualifications:**

1. All delegates must be registered Girl Scouts as of March 15, 2018
2. Must be physically fit with Health Examination Form duly signed by the participant and physician.
3. Must have attended school/district/councilwide camp
4. Must have 2 chaperons for every 6-8 junior Girl Scouts
5. Must have attended a patrol pre-camp training
6. Must have submitted the duly accomplished Application Form for Girls, Application Form for Adult, Parent's consent and Medical Certificate

NOTE: The adult chaperon for Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts can only assist their girls during settling down. They will attend the Troop Leaders' Forum in a separate venue intended for them

> **MEALS: In camp** April 10, 2017 – (Afternoon Snacks)
April 15, 2017 - Last Meal (Morning Snacks)


