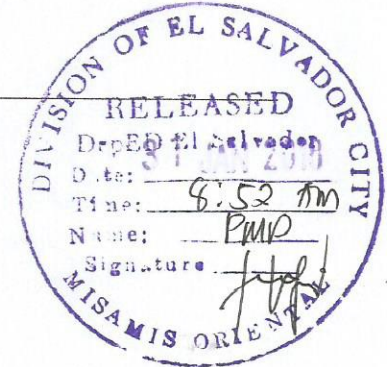

**SUBJECT: 2018 MTAP DEPED MATH CHALLENGE DIVISION FINAL ROUND**

**DATE/s: February 8, 2018 and (Elementary) and February 9, 2018 (Secondary)**

1. The Metrobank Foundation Inc., Mathematics Association of the Philippines and the Department of Education announces the holding of the 2018 Metrobank-MTAP DepEd Math Challenge Division Finals bagged with the theme, "Moving Forward Through Excellence in Mathematics". This will be administered on February 8, 2018 for Elementary level and February 9, 2018 for Secondary Level At El Salvador City Central School and El Salvador City National High School. The competition will start at exactly 8:00 o'clock in the morning.
2. The overall objective of the competition is to contribute in improving the quality of Mathematics Education. Specifically, it aims to:
  - A. Awaken greater interest in Mathematics among Grade 1 to 10 learners in both public and private schools all over the country;
  - B. Encourage learners to strive for excellence in mathematics;
  - C. Encourage mastery of basic mathematical skills;
  - D. Discover mathematical talents among students;
  - E. Develop the values of hard work, perseverance, honesty, teamwork and sportsmanship, and;
  - F. Provide learners with opportunities in leadership and cooperative undertaking.
3. The competition shall be participated in by Grade 1 to 10 learners. However, only Grade 6 and Grade 10 learners can participate in the regional and national levels.
4. Expenses for meals, snacks of working officials and tarpaulin during the elimination round is chargeable to Division MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures/policies, rules and regulations, while snacks and meals for the participants is subject to school Funds, PTA and school MOOE..
5. The participants are expected to report to the elimination center at exactly 7:00am.
6. Arrangements for substitute teachers must be facilitated earlier to ensure that classes of the participating teachers/coaches/officials will not be disrupted

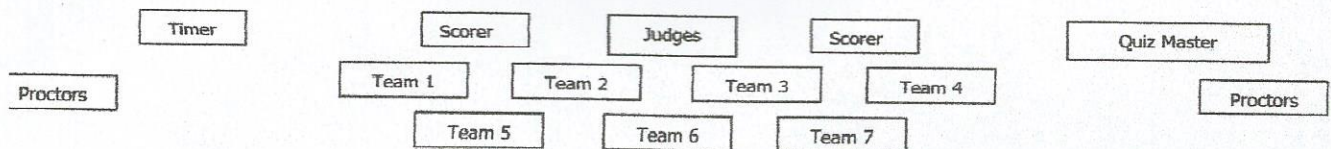

19. Each answer will be written on the official answer slips provided. As soon as the buzzer rings, everybody must stop writing.
20. Proctors will collect the answer slips and give them to the judges who sort them into two sets: those with correct answers and those with wrong answers.
21. One of the judges will announce the teams with the correct answer. The scorers record the points obtained by each team for each correct answer.
22. Answers must be given complete with units and to the required accuracy. However if the unit is already given in the way the question is asked, it need not be given in the answer.
23. The teams will be ranked according to their total score in the three parts to determine the winners.
24. In case of a tie among any of the teams vying for the first three places, a set of 3 questions will be given to break the tie, one from each category of questions. If the tie is not broken after the three questions, "do or die" questions will be given.

**COMPLAINTS OR CLARIFICATIONS**

25. Only the official contestants may raise a complaint or clarification.
26. Complaints on a given question should be made before the next question is asked. This should be directed to the Chairman of the Board of Judges.
27. The following are responsible for settling all questions, including protest, which may arise in the course of the competition:
  - **Elimination Round to the Division Finals** - Department of Education (DepEd)
  - **Regional Finals** - Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines, Inc. (MTAP)
  - **National Finals** - Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI)

**SUGGESTED PHYSICAL ARRANGEMENT:**



28. Each team of 2 will be seated in such a way that they can discuss their answers. They must be facing the judges.

**MANPOWER REQUIREMENT:**

29. Each venue requires the following support staff: 3 Judges, 1 Quizmaster, 2 Scorers (1 on the board/project on screen and 1 manual scoring using the score sheet), 1 timer, 1 proctor for every 4 to 5 teams.

**BOARD OF JUDGES:**

30. There will be a panel of three judges composed of persons competent in the field of Mathematics.
31. The board of judges shall resolve complaints and problems regarding the test questions and their respective answers.
32. All decisions of the board of judges shall be final.

## II. DIVISION FINALS

15. The Division Finals is a written-oral team competition.
16. Each team will be provided with slips of paper for the answer to each question. Before the first question, they will write their team identification on each slip.
17. There shall be 20 questions: 10 fifteen-second questions worth 2 points each, 5 thirty-second questions worth 3 points each and 5 one-minute questions worth 5 points each for a total of 60 points.
  - a. The 15-second questions are to be answered mentally. There will be no writing anywhere, neither on paper, the table, etc. The team, of two, will work together as one to discuss their answer to the question. They may start discussing their solution after the first reading of each question.
  - b. For the 30-second questions, scratch paper will be provided for each team-contestant. Contestants may begin solving as soon as they wish.
  - c. For 1-minute questions, a copy of the questions will be provided for each team. Scratch papers will be provided.
18. The quizmaster will read each question twice, after which he/she gives the GO signal. The timer starts when the quizmaster gives the GO signal.
