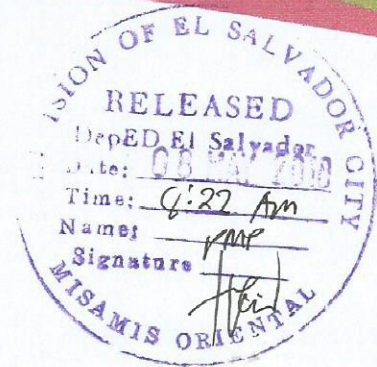

Subject: Seminar-Workshop on Print and Broadcast Journalism Cum Evaluation and Planning on Campus Journalism Activities

1. Pursuant to Section 8 of Republic Act No. 7079, otherwise known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, this Office hereby announces the conduct of Seminar-Workshop on Print and Broadcast Journalism Cum Evaluation and Planning on Campus Journalism Activities on May 28-29, 2018 at Apple Tree, Taboc, Opol, Misamis Oriental.

2. All public and private elementary and secondary school heads of this Division are advised to identify and submit to this office the name of your school journalism advisers for both English and Filipino for SY 2018-2019 on May 11, 2018.

3. The training aims to:

- A. Hone teachers journalistic skills and empower them to be effective channel of information and efficient molders of campus journalists;
- B. Update campus journalism advisers of the newest guidelines and criteria for the different journalistic contests;
- C. Train the participants in lay out and page design, collaborative desktop publishing, and update them on the various content trends on school paper/publication; and
- D. Provide adequate attention and monitoring of the progress and development of the journalistic writing skills of campus journalism advisers for School Year 2017 - 2018.

4. The two-day training is a live-in seminar and a registration fee of Php2,500.00 shall be charged to each participant to defray the expenses of the participants' meals and accommodations, the speaker's honorarium, transportation and other incidental expenses relative to the conduct of said training. Expenses are chargeable to school downloaded funds (MOOE) and other source of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures. Deadline of payment will be on May 8-9, 2018 at the Division Cashier.

5. Moreover, participants are required to bring Action Plan, laptop (Wi-Fi ready or with mobile broadband modem) digital camera, and video recorder.
