- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 23., s 2015 entitled Student Led School Watching and Hazard Mapping, all schools are reminded to conduct the said activity following the steps stipulated in the order and aims to instruct all public elementary and secondary in the specific engagement of learners identifying and addressing hazards.
- 2. It also aims to improve student's level of awareness on the potential hazards and risk within and around schools, increase the participation of children in addressing disaster by reducing vulnerabilities and inculcate a culture of safety in the day-to day experience of children in

The student-led-School watching and hazard mapping shall be conducted on the scheduled school visits indicated in a separate Division Memorandum, and the lists of identified hazards and risk together with a copy of the hazard map shall be submitted to Division Disaster Risk Reduction and Management thru Mr. Jeffrey M. Martinez-Administrative Officer V- DRRM Coordinator not later than July 30, 2018.
