
Subject: 6th A Happy MisOr Scout Jamboree

SCOUTING MONTH CELEBRATION SUBJECT

- 1. October of every year is the celebration of Scouting Month as declared under Presidential Proclamation No. 1326. The same proclamation upheld the Constitutional declaration which provides that the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being, and that it shall inculcate in the youth, patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs.
- 2. The theme for the celebration of the Scouting Month is "Scouts: Cultivating A Happy and Better MisOr";
- 3. All public and private elementary and secondary schools and Schools District Offices are enjoined to coordinate with their respective Local Government Units, organize their Scouts to lead and actively participate (in Type-A Uniform) during the Flag Raising Ceremony of the LGUs in their locality on October 1, 2018, Monday in the Municipalities and Barangays to maximize Scouting visibility and enhance Scouting's image to its stakeholders in the community.
- 4. All public and private elementary and secondary schools, Schools District are also encouraged to plan and conduct activities for the whole month of October focused on the following areas:
 - Leadership, Character and Skills Development;
 - Patriotism and Nationalism; and,
 - Community Service and Environmental Projects such as Tree Planting, Mangrove Reforestation, Waste Segregation and Recycling, Canals and Water Ways De-clogging, Coastal Clean Up Activities.
- 5. All participants must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines to be covered by its Financial Assistance Program (FAP) in case of eventualities.



- Reports on the activities conducted by the schools and schools districts, with proper documentations, shall be submitted to the Council and Division Office on October 26, 2018;
- 7. Participation and involvement to the activities conducted will pre-qualify the Unit Leaders/Outfit Advisors for the BSP Service and Merit Awards for Unit Leaders as provided in DepEd Order No. 76 s. 2012, advance the Scouts to the next higher rank and pre-qualify them to earn the WOSM Better World Programmes – the Messengers of Peace (MOP) Initiatives; World Scout Environment Programme (WSEP); and the Scouts of the World Award (SWA);
