Subject: 34th Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) Regional Encampment

Date: March 05, 2019

1. This is to inform the field that the Girl Scouts of the Philippines – Eastern Mindanao Region will conduct its 34th Regional Encampment with theme: “Grow, Soar & Pursue: Spirituality, Patriotism & Self-Worth” on April 10 – 15, 2019 at Camp Telesfora Ong Oh Program and Training Center, Tabay, Agusan del Norte.
2. Expected participants are Junior, Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts with Adult chaperone (Troop Leaders) with minimum of 50 delegates per council, but no limit to the maximum.
3. Qualifications:
 - a. Delegates must be a registered Girl Scout as of March 15, 2018
 - b. Must be physically fit with Health Examination Form duly signed by the participant and physician.
 - c. Must have attended school/district/councilwide camp
 - d. Must have 2 chaperons for every 6-8 Junior Girl Scouts
 - e. Must have attended a patrol pre-camp training
 - f. Must have submitted the duly accomplished Application Form for Girls, Application Form for Adult, Parent’s Consent and Medical Certificate

Note: The adult chaperone for Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts can only assist their girls during settling down. They will attend the Troop Leaders’ Forum in a separate venue intended for them.
4. Registration fee is Php 3,500.00 per camper/ Php 3,000.00 Sr. Troop Leaders Chaperon (to cover food, camp souvenirs, fare and entrances during offsite adventures, program and required activity materials. Charged to Local School Board/ MOOE Funds, subject to the usual auditing and



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accounting procedures.

5. First meal is April 10, 2019 – Afternoon Snacks and last meal is April 15, 2019 – Morning Snacks.
