1.	Facilitate the assessment of school electrical system to make necessary repairs and/or upgrades to prevent fire incident.			
2.	Repairs minor classroom damage such as broken windows, doors, blackboards, roofs, etc.

4.	Make sure that corridors and pathways are unobstructed and that all sharp, protruding objects which may cause harm to students are removed.

	Identify alternative sources and/or maintain supply of drinking water within the school.			
	Ensure that students, teachers, and personnel have identification cards with relevant information.
