1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum(RM) No. 243, s. 2019 Re: Implementation of Project CNR (ROX Reading Program) and in line with the Division Strategic Directions anchored on the Regional Strategic Directions, this Office shall conduct an orientation on the implementing guidelines of Project CNR and the Basa ni ELSA a comprehensive reading program of the Division of El Salvador City which aims to improve the reading performance and literacy level of the learners on May 31, 2019 at Cogon National High School, Cogon, El Salvador City.
