SIMULTANEOUS SCHOOL-BASED POSTER MAKING CONTEST

1. This Office, in coordination with the Citizens' Disaster Response Center Foundation Inc. (CDRC), Quezon City, will conduct a simultaneous school-based Poster Making Contest on August 22, 2019, at 9:30 a.m.
2. All public and private elementary schools in the region are encouraged to conduct the activity. The Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall select top-three winning entries per category and shall be submitted to Myron Gil D. Talosig, OIC-Chief, ESSD, on or before September 4. Regional winning entries shall be submitted to the organizer on September 20.
3. The participants shall think of ways on how the community can reduce disaster risks. Only one theme per artwork.
4. The theme for Category A (7-9 years old) includes floods/typhoons, volcanic eruption/lahar, earthquake, fire, landslide, environmental destruction due to mining, illegal logging, and other projects.
5. The theme for Category B (10-12 years old) includes drought, fishkill/red tide, infestation, epidemic, war/armed conflict, and climate change.
6. The participants shall use any medium. Design shall be drawn on a 1/4 (20"X15") illustration board. Details and mechanics of this contest are provided in Attachment No. 1 of this Regional Memorandum.

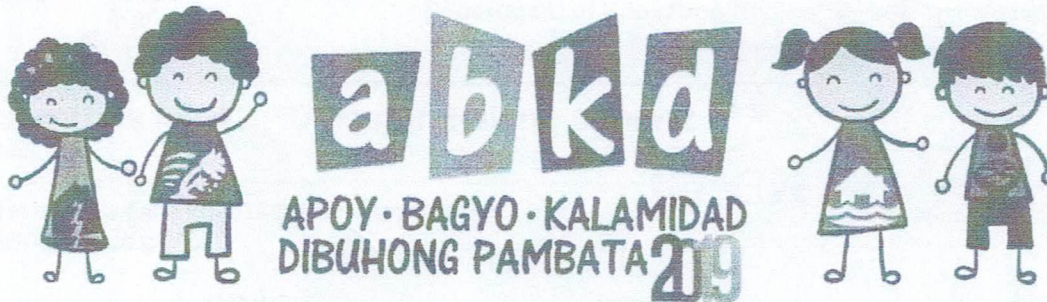

Winners will be informed through phone or by letter. Major prize winners will get Php5,000 cash prize each. Other winners will receive Php1,000 each. Prizes not claimed within six (6) months will be forfeited. Winning entries shall become CDRC property and will be featured in the 2020 CDRC Disaster Preparedness Calendar and other promotional materials. Non-winning entries can be reclaimed at the CDRC office. Entries not claimed within 60 days after the announcement of winners shall be considered donations to CDRC.
