1. In consonance with DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012 re: Revitalizing the Scouting Movement in the entire Country, as calendared the BSP-Misamis Oriental Council will conduct the **2nd A Happy MisOr Kawan Holiday and KAB Olympics for the El Salvador City Scouting Area with the Theme: "Tamang Pagsasanay at Mabuting Asal Para sa Maunlad na MisOr"** on March 14-15, 2020 at El Salvador City Central School.
2. The Kawan Holiday and KAB Olympics aim to provide meaningful activities and avenue to showcase the knowledge and skills of KAB Scouts. It also seeks to inculcate values such as discipline, self-control, efficiency, teamwork and leadership while engaging with fellow scouts in friendly competitions in scouting games and BSP Peace, Road and Safety Initiatives.
The qualifications for participation are as follows:
 - a) Currently registered to the BSP as KAB Scout
 - b) Physically Fit as certified by a physician; and
 - c) Parent's consent
3. A registration of **TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (P250.00)** will be charged each participant to cover expenses for souvenir shirt, certificate, Activity ID, administrative cost, activity materials and other operational expenses.
4. In the activities of this nature, it is suggested that contingent of each scouting district/institution must provide their own food and other basic requirements that will be sufficient throughout the whole duration of the event.
5. Encampment expenses may be charged to MOOE/local funds or Local School Board Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.
