- c. Coordinate with the City Health Office for the implementation of its guidelines in response to the situation, including any decision for school/office lockdown or suspension of classes/work in specific localities should a need arise;
- d. Provide technical assistance in response to the nCoV ARD in schools;
- e. Work with the City Health Office on referral, management and treatment of cases using the prescribed Medical Referral Form;
- f. Submit report on health situation of schools on or before 12:00 NN every Friday;
- g. Supervise the Operations Group of the Task Force; Operational Level;
- h. Perform such other functions and activities as maybe necessary to carry out the provisions of this Memorandum;
