**GIRL SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES (GSP) 35TH REGIONAL CAMP WITH
THEME: "GSP AT 80: EMPOWERING GIRLS TO LEAD AND SUCCEED"**

1. The field is hereby informed of the 35th Regional Camp with theme: "GSP at 80: Empowering Girls to Lead and Succeed" on April 15 – 20, 2020 at Alano Program and Training Center, Toril, Davao City.
2. This camp aims to provide opportunity to young girls to attend higher camp in the regional level with the vision of empowering women and girls in unleashing the leaders in themselves and progressing towards positive change.
3. A registration fee of Php 3,850.00 will be collected per camper to cover for food, camp souvenirs, fare and entrances during offsite adventures, program and required activity materials. This will be charged to local funds/ Local School Board subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

NOTE: Meals in camp: First Meal (April 15, 2020) – afternoon snacks;
Last Meal (April 20, 2020) – morning snacks.

4. Expected participants are Junior, Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts with Adult Chaperone (Troop Leaders) but must observe to the following qualifications:
 - a. Must be a registered Girl Scout as of March 8, 2020;
 - b. Must be physically fit with Health Examination Form duly signed by the participant and physician
 - c. Must have attended school/district/ councilwide camp;
 - d. Must have 2 chaperones for every 6-8 Junior Girl Scout;
 - e. Must have attended a patrol pre-camp training;
 - f. Must have submitted the duly accomplished Application Form for Girls, Application Form for Adult, Parent's consent and Medical Certificate





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NOTE: The adult chaperone for Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts can only assist their girls during settling down. They will attend the Troop Leaders' Forum in a separate venue intended for them.
