1. In connection with DepEd Memorandum No 89, s. 2015, *re: Implementation of the Gulayan Sa Paaralan (GPP) for SY 2020-2021*, DepEd El Salvador in partnership with the Office of the Provincial Agriculture-El Salvador City promote school gardening and vegetable production among the schools in the division to address malnutrition and complement the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP).
