1. To ensure a responsive curriculum implementation, this Office will conduct the Program Management Review in the New Learning Landscape on April 8, 2021 at Mc Donald's Function Room, Pedro Sa Baculio, El Salvador City.
2. The activity aims to achieve the following:
 - a. evaluate the learners' performance for the first and second quarter in all learning areas from Kindergarten to Senior High School;
 - b. discuss policy support, program directions, updates, issues/concerns on the curriculum support system; and
 - c. prepare quarterly report and plan of action to improve learning outcomes.
3. Participants of this activity are the school heads, education program supervisors and the technical working group.

Each school shall prepare a 5-8 minutes slide presentation on the data of the first quarter and second quarter grades, characterization by learning according to grade level, gains, challenges, and interventions. The template of the powerpoint presentation shall be sent to the school's official email account. The presentation shall be emailed to cid.elsalvadorcity@deped.gov.ph on or before April 7, 2021.
5. Food, accommodation, supplies and materials shall be charged to HRTD funds.





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6. Travel expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
