28 August 2021 9:30-11:00 a.m.	When Child Experiences Are Not Enough: How To Mitigate The Effects of Social Isolation This webinar will discuss how social isolation is affecting the social and



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	emotional development of children. It will also discuss practical and evidence-based strategies on how to address these effects.
25 September 2021 9:30-11:00 a.m.	Practical Tips in Caring for Your Infant This webinar will discuss care of the infant from different aspects: health maintenance, disease prevention, vaccines, nutrition and feeding.
23 October 2021 9:30-11:00 a.m.	Online and Home Learning After a Year: Best Practices This webinar will discuss how to help parents with online and home learning. It will present evidence-based effective strategies to make learning effective using online platforms and home-based support.
27 November 2021 9:30-11:00 a.m.	COVID-19 Vaccines for Children This webinar will discuss the latest evidence on COVID-19 vaccines as used for children.
