1. Relative to the OUA MEMO 00-0621-0039, *Re: Reiteration of the Schedule and Implementing Guidelines for the 2nd Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED)*, this Office inform the field to participate in the conduct of 2nd Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) on June 10, 2021 at 9:00 in the morning.
2. This drill aims to ensure awareness and preparedness on the impending threat of the inevitable occurrence of an earthquake, even amid the pandemic, the Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) campaign in NSED using distant means must be intensified.
3. All DepEd personnel and learners are enjoined to practice the “duck, cover, and hold” procedures simultaneously at the set time. Other post-activity exercises such as virtual earthquake drills, tabletop, and functional exercises may also be done while adhering to the minimum public health standards.
4. Proper documentation and post-activity evaluation of the said drill is required. The School, Division, and Region DRRM Coordinators shall





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accomplish the Google form not later than five (5) working days after the quarterly NSED.

5. Further, NSED report shall be fill out by DRRM Coordinators via Google form link:
