Enclosure 1 GUIDELINES ON THE CONDUCT OF THE 2021 NTD/WTD

I. NTD SIMULTANEOUS BROADCAST

All Regional Directors (RDs), Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs), District Supervisors, and Schools Heads are enjoined to actively lead <u>virtual</u> <u>activities</u> for the NTM, NTD, and WTD celebrations. Each regional celebration on October 5, 2021 will be broadcast or patched live to the National celebration hosted by DepEd Regional Office VII.

The Technical Working Group from Central Office will meet all Regional Partnership Focal Persons (RPFPs) together with the Regional Information and Communications Technology (ICT) coordinator and Regional Public Affairs coordinator on **September 10, 2021** at **2:00 p.m.**

II. TEACHERS GOT TALENT

As part of this year's National Teachers' Day / World Teachers' Day Celebrations, we will once again hold the Teachers Got Talent (TGT) Competition.

NTD CONTEST GUIDELINES ON TEACHERS GOT TALENT

- 1. The participants are reminded to observe and follow minimum health standards such as wearing of facemasks/face shields, regular washing of hands, using disinfectants like alcohol and sanitizers, and observing social distancing, consistent with the guidelines from Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF), Department of Health (DOH), and the Department of Education (DepEd) and local government units (LGUs).
- The contest is open to public school teachers from all Regions.
- The contest is open to any type of act or performance such as singing, dancing, acting, etc.
- 4. Each interested individual or group shall coordinate with their regional office for the application.
- 5. The region must have a maximum of three (3) endorsed participants to the Central Office. If not conducting any region-wide screening; respective

regions must appoint three (3) contestants. All participants shall sign the online registration form through this link: https://bit.ly/37iVhTa

- 6. The performance will be pre-recorded and the videographer can utilize different angles using a mobile phone, digital camera, among other means. The presentation should last for a maximum of **seven (7) minutes only**. Two (2) points will automatically be deducted for each minute in excess of the allowed duration.
- 7. Once the video recording is available, contestants shall upload the video with a brief caption on the 2021 Teachers Got Talent group page: https://bit.ly/3f0hutv. The online registration form shall also be filled out.
- 8. All entries should be submitted not later than **September 20, 2021**, at **5:00 p.m.** All entries received beyond the said time shall no longer be considered.
- 9. Contestants shall perform live in showcasing their talents. Foreseeing possible internet connectivity interruption, the contestants are also requested to prepare a recorded video of their performances as a backup. This recorded video of their final performance for the competition must be sent to the TGT program committee not later than **Friday, October 1, 2021**.
- 10. The scores will be tallied at the end of the three (3) performances, and the announcement will follow shortly.
- 11. The judges' decisions are final and cannot be subjected to review, debate, contest, or dispute.
- 12. The criteria for judging are as follows:
- a) Talent, Interpretation, and Skill 50%
- b) Originality and Creativity 25%
- c) Projection and Overall Impact 25%
- 13. Winners of this year's TGT competition may either get cash prizes subject to the approval of the management and to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
