The organization has achieved more than it expected in its first year. However, victories are better celebrated when they have created an impact on their stakeholders. They become meaningful when they remain true to their purpose. These achievements become of greater value when they contribute to the vision.

UP Kalinaw recognizes its mission in taking part in the discourse on the peace-building process in Mindanao. It also believes that the youth has a role to play in this pursuit. It is through upholding social awareness and social responsibility that everyone can contribute to making steps towards peace. And through the embodiment of cultural sensitivity, we can come up with a solution that is inclusive and appropriate for every culture.

In this year's **PAGSAULOG**, UP Kalinaw seeks to explore the roots it has planted and the steps it will take to make an impact in society. 


## Panday Kalinaw

**PANDAY KALINAW: Mindanaoan Youth as Pillar of Peace** is an anthology of the stories of key Mindanaoan youth figures and their efforts and contribution to the peace-building process in Mindanao. These youth representatives will talk about the socio-cultural context of their advocacies and their hopes and call to action to the youth in Mindanao.

## e-Paskin Educational Pubs

**e-Paskin** is like the Bisaya word "ipaskin" which literally means "to put up (a poster)". UP Kalinaw's e-Paskin is a series of educational publications showcasing the organization, discussing Mindanao history, its struggles and its peoples, and featuring some key Mindanaoan figures who have significantly contributed to the just peace and genuine development in Mindanao. These publication materials are posted throughout the day during the week-long run of PAGSAULOG I.



## Baruganan: Position Paper Competition

PAGSAULOG I's headline competition, **Baruganan**, is a position paper competition that aims to provide a platform for the youth to share their values and principles, and their stand regarding the pressing issues of Mindanao. The winners will be recognized at the end of PAGSAULOG I.
