During this session, the design of the Third National Summit will be explained to the children-learners to elicit their inputs during the ensuing break-out session. The children-learners will be informed that they will be divided into fifteen (15) breakout groups where they will be engaging in child-led discussions about the guide questions. The groupings will mix representatives from different regions, sectors, and backgrounds to balance out the number of members in a group while ensuring that all sectors are represented in the sharing in the Pre-Summit plenary session and in the Summit proper. Each group will be assigned a particular dimension of the RBE in DepEd – right to access, right to quality and right to respect in the learning environment – to ensure that all the dimensions are covered. All groups will also be given guide questions pertaining to all the dimensions of RBE.
