RESUMPTION OF THE PILOT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LIMITED FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES AND START OF CLASSES FOR THE EXPANSION SCHOOLS

This Division

1. Relative to the recently released IATF Resolution No. 161-A which placed the province of Misamis Oriental under Alert Level 2, this Office informs the Division Composite Team and the concerned school heads for the resumption of the Pilot Implementation of the Limited Face-to-Face Classes and the commencement of the Expansion Limited Face-to-Face Classes of the Pre-Identified Schools.
2. Members of the Division Composite Team, Education Program Supervisors/Technical Assistance Providers (EPS/TAP) are enjoined to extend various assistance to the identified schools to ensure the final preparation within the week and the smooth implementation.
3. It is further directed that everyone must ensure the strict compliance with the established health and safety protocols as prescribed by the City Government/Local Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) and the City Health Office/Department of Health (DOH).
4. These are the preliminary activities to be undertaken by the concerned personnel:
 - February 18 - Orientation for the Grade 4 to 6 Parents/Guardians
Dry-Run for the Actual Classes
 - February 21 - Resumption of Pilot Limited Face-to-Face Classes
Start of Classes for Grades 4-6 in
San Francisco de Asis Elementary School
 - February 22-24 - Consultative Conference and Dry-Run in other schools
 - February 28 - Start of Expansion Classes in other schools
