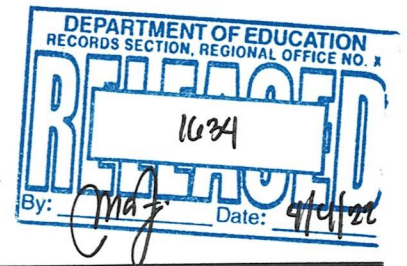

The Philippine Science High School – Central Mindanao Campus will be organizing the first-ever **Region-wide Math-Physics Challenge 2022** this **April 25-26, 2022**. It is an online quiz bee intended for Grade 5 students from any public or private schools in Northern Mindanao with the goal of promoting STEM education in the region as well as the love for Math and Physics.

In line with this, we would like to seek assistance from your office in disseminating information to all public and private schools in Region X about this event. When	Elimination Round: April 25, 2022 from 1:00-2:00 PM Final Round: April 26, 2022 from 1:00-4:00 PM
Where	Online via Zoom and live stream via Facebook Live
How	Register thru https://bit.ly/RWMPC2022 on or before April 20, 2022
Additional Info	Coaches must input in the registration form the contestants: (i) recent valid school IDs; (ii) photos of the participants holding their respective school IDs; (iii) certification from school head that participants are currently enrolled. Schools must ensure their participants have appropriate tools and equipment to join the online event (e.g., stable internet connection with backups, fully-charged laptops or desktops with working cameras & microphones, etc.).

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Participants are required to provide a 360-view of the room where they will take the quiz. Strictly no parents, teacher, etc. shall be in the same room with the participant.

Only 10 schools will advance to the final round. The top 5 winners in the final round will receive the following:

- 1st Place: Php 5,000.00 + certificate + token
- 2nd Place: Php 4,000.00 + certificate + token
- 3rd Place: Php 3,000.00 + certificate + token
- 4th Place: Php 2,000.00 + certificate
- 5th Place: Php 1,000.00 + certificate

REGION-WIDE MATH-PHYSICS CHALLENGE 2022

GENERAL INFORMATION

The PSHS-Central Mindanao Campus organizes the Region-wide Math-Physics Challenge 2022 with the goal of attracting brilliant students around Region X to enroll in PSHS as well as promoting STEM education in the region. It is an online quiz bee to be held on **April 26, 2022 (Tuesday) at 1:00-4:00 PM** and will cover 3rd and 4th quarter topics in Grade 5 Science & Mathematics of K-12 Basic Education Curriculum.

PARTICIPATION

- A. Any public or private schools in Northern Mindanao are eligible to nominate one official Grade 5 contestant and one substitute contestant. The substitute contestant will replace the official participant in case he/she cannot make it to the competition proper before the start of the elimination round.
- B. The organizers must be informed (either thru email or SMS) when a team decides to utilize its substitute contestant at least 1 hour before the start of the event.
- C. Joining this competition means that the contestants will only submit answers that are the result of their personal effort. The use of calculators, mobile apps, or computer software, consultation with anyone, and using physical or online references is prohibited. Joining the competition shall also mean being aware of the disqualification if proven to have violated the rules.

REGISTRATION

- A. The registration period is until **April 20, 2022 (Wednesday) at 11:59 PM**.
- B. Coach of interested schools must register thru <https://bit.ly/RWMPC2022>. In this form, the coach must provide the contestants' (both official and substitute) recent valid school IDs, photos of the participants holding their respective school IDs, and certification from the school head that the participants are currently enrolled in their respective school.
- C. The email addresses to be used throughout the competition and contact numbers of both the coach and each of the participating students will also be required. The coach shall also provide his/her personal GCash number. He/she shall be the one responsible for the prize distribution of the winning team.
- D. Additional instructions will be regularly communicated to the qualified participants via email. The organizers reserve the right to extend the registration period. In case of such adjustments, announcements will be communicated through email.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- A. The competition will be held online, contestants are required to prepare the requirement to participate in the competition as follows:
 1. personal email account for important announcements and communication;
 2. reliable internet connection;
 3. desktop or laptop or tablet with a camera and an installed Zoom app.
 4. Zoom account.

- B. It is the participants' responsibility to regularly check their email for competition details and updates. **The organizers will not be liable for the participant's non-compliance with the contest mechanics due to failure to read updates sent through email.**
- C. The contestants are highly encouraged to prepare a backup internet connection device (such as pocket WIFI, a mobile phone tether, and a powerbank) in case of internet connection problems and power interruptions. Devices such as laptops, tablets, and mobile phones that will be used during the competition should be fully charged before the start of the competition to minimize technical problems during the contest proper.
- D. Laptop use or any device with enough screen size for visibility purposes is also highly advised. The organizers will not be responsible for missed out or misinterpreted contest mechanics.
- E. The organizers empathize that not everyone has access to a stable/reliable internet connection, nor does everyone have enough electrical devices at home. Regrettably, they will be unable to accommodate these limitations. Through best efforts, the competition will move on by making the necessary adjustments to ensure the safety of all the participants and individuals involved while maintaining the integrity of the competition.

ELIMINATION ROUND

- A. The elimination round will be held online via [Zoom](#) on **April 25, 2022 (Monday)** from **1:00-2:00 PM**. In the event that only 10 schools (or less) registered for the competition, no more elimination round will be conducted. The schools will then proceed directly to the final round the following day.
- B. The elimination round will be administered thru an online quizzing form which will be revealed during the event. There will be 20 questions in the elimination round with varying points depending on their level of difficulty. The top 10 highest scorers in the elimination will then proceed to the final round.
- C. Schools who qualified for the final round will be notified via email. List of qualifiers will also be posted in PSHS-CMC official Facebook Page.

FINAL ROUND

- A. The final round will be held again via [Zoom](#) and will also be streamed on the PSHS-CMC Facebook page on **April 26, 2022 (Tuesday)**.
- B. A dry-run will be conducted from **11:00 AM-12:00 NN** while the actual competition will take place from **1:00-4:00 PM**. Attendance to the dry-run is required for all participants who qualified for the final round to check their devices, internet connectivity, etc.
- C. Also, to maintain proper decorum in the quiz bee proper, only the contestants and organizers will be allowed to enter the Zoom room. The coaches, parents, and other interested viewers can watch the competition via Facebook Live.
- D. When entering the Zoom room, the contestants must rename their account into their school's name (e.g., San Pedro Central Elementary School). Each participant is required

- to turn on their camera and microphone. The camera should be able to capture the face of the participant.
- E. The competition will be divided into 3 categories: Easy, Average, and Difficult.
- Easy Round**
- Six (6) questions will be asked.
 - Each contestant will be given thirty (30) seconds to answer each question.
 - A correct answer garners 5 points. Wrong answers and no answers will garner no points.
- Average Round**
- Six (6) questions will be asked.
 - Each contestant will be given sixty (60) seconds to answer each question.
 - A correct answer garners 7 points. Wrong answers and no answers will garner no points.
- Difficult Round**
- Six (6) questions will be asked.
 - Each contestant will be given ninety (90) seconds to answer each question.
 - A correct answer garners 10 points. Wrong answers and no answers will garner no points.
- F. The accumulated points from the Easy, Average, and Difficult Rounds shall determine the winners for this competition.
- G. In case of a tie, a clincher round will be conducted composed of 6 questions with varying points.
- H. Any protests will be resolved by the judges and organizers and their decision is final and irrevocable.

CERTIFICATES & PRIZES

- A. All participants and coaches will receive certificates for their participation.
- B. Additionally, the final round winners will receive certificates of recognition, tokens, and the following prizes:
- 1st Place: Php 5,000.00 + certificate of recognition + token
 - 2nd Place: Php 4,000.00 + certificate of recognition + token
 - 3rd Place: Php 3,000.00 + certificate of recognition + token
 - 4th Place: Php 2,000.00
 - 5th Place: Php 1,000.00
- C. The winners of this competition will also be announced via Facebook Live and will be posted on the Facebook page of PSHS-CMC.
