1. This Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division hereby informs the field on the conduct of **Division Virtual Training on Scaling Up PRIMALS PLUS** on August 1-3, 2022, 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. via google meet. The link shall be provided through the school’s official e-mail address or the official Facebook messenger of the concerned participants.
2. The activity aims to:
  - a. enhance the quality of instruction; and
  - b. capacitate school leaders and teachers on pedagogical competence to improve learning outcomes.
3. The participants to this activity are the select Junior High School teachers, school heads and the Education Program SupervisorS in different learning areas. Participants are expected to prepare their own laptop with mouse and to secure internet connectivity.
4. The participants shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 52, s. 2003 entitled *Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*. On the other hand, non-teaching staff shall be provided with Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on *Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered*.
5. Attendance of the teacher-participants shall be strictly monitored by their respective learning area supervisors. Moreover, the teachers-participants shall prepare two copies form 48 (DTR) for a three-day service credit which will be
