

- 2. Hence, the school heads and mentors are reminded of the following timeline of activities:

a.	February – August 2022	Batch 1 Year 1 Completion of Self-paced Modules (School-based)
b.	February - August 2022	Batch 1 Year 1 Coaching and Mentoring (School-based)
c.	February - August 2022	Batch 1 Year 1  LAC Sessions (School-based)
d.	August - December 2022	Batch 1 Year 2 Coaching and Mentoring (School-based)
e.	August – December 2022	Batch 1 Year 2  LAC Sessions (School-based)

3. To monitor the compliance with the IPBT Implementation, all schools with newly-hired teachers for SY 2019 – 2022, SY 2020 – 2021, and SY 2021 – 2022 must ensure their implementation and visit <a href="https://bit.lv/IPBT2022Materials">https://bit.lv/IPBT2022Materials</a>, to download all IPBT instructional materials, videos, and modules. Similarly, they shall prepare the following reports:
