

In compliance to Republic Act 10533, Sec 2, and in adherence to DepEd Order No 14, s. 2018 re Policy Guidelines on the Administration of the Revised Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil IRI), DepEd Order No. 45, s. 2002 re Reading Literacy Program in the Elementary Schools, Regional Memorandum No. 391, s. 2022, and in support to “Every Child A Reader” Program (ECARP), this Office directs all School Heads and Technical Assistance Provider to join a reorientation activity on the Division Reading Program - GEMs 24K Basa ni ELSA Reading Program on November 24, 2022, 1:00 p.m. at Cogon National High School, Cogon, El Salvador City.
2. Participants to this activity are the Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads, Education Program Supervisors, Chief Education Supervisor of the Curriculum Implementation Division and the Technical Working Group.
3. School Heads are advised to bring a copy of their school-based reading program, pretest results of the Phil IRI and the copy of the school program.
4. The participants are encouraged to observe health protocols such as physical distancing and the wearing of face masks at all times.

This Office shall adhere to Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in receiving the General Plan of Activities and attending to clarification/queries relative to the Reorientation on Division Reading Program for School Heads and Technical Assistance Provider.
