RE CONDUCT OF DIVISION-WIDE READ-A-THON ACTIVITIES IN CELEBRATION
OF THE NATIONAL READING MONTH**

1. In reference to Division Memorandum No. 492, s. 2022 re Conduct of Division-wide Read-A-Thon Activities in Celebration of the National Reading Month, the field is hereby informed of the following correction and addendum:

A. The reference cited should be Republic Act 10556 known as “The Araw ng Pagbasa,” instead of Republic Act 10566.

B. Each school is required to submit a video of the performance of their Top 1 Winner of the following events; namely, (1) Best in Story Retelling for Grade 4; (2) Best in Oral Interpretation for Grade 5, as entry to the Division-wide Read-A-Thon Activities for the National Reading Month Celebration. Deadline of submission for videos of the Top 1 winner in each school shall be on November 24, 2022.

C. Moreover, Division-wide selection for Best in Vocabulary for Grade 6, and Best Team Readers for Grade 3 (in Filipino) and Grade 5 (English) shall be done on November 25, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. through Google Meet. Link for Vocabulary shall be provided by Margie R. Valmoria, Education Program Supervisor in English; while, link for Team Readers shall be provided by Genevieve E. Lusterio, Education Program Supervisor in Filipino. Reading selection shall be provided in the afternoon of November 24, 2022.

2. For queries and clarifications, please contact the Division Reading Coordinators – Margie R. Valmoria and Genevieve E. Lusterio, through direct message or through group chats and text message.

3. The participants are always encouraged to observe health protocols such as physical distancing and the wearing of face masks at all times.

4. This Office shall adhere to Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in receiving the General Plan of Activities and attending to clarification/queries relative to the Conduct of the Division-wide Read-A-Thon Activities in Celebration of the National Reading Month.
