Introduction

The Learning Effectively through Enhanced and Evidence-based Pedagogies (LEEP) Program of Knowledge Channel Foundation aims to enable its participants to operate and contextualize K-12 concepts in classroom activities using enhanced and evidence-based pedagogies and Knowledge Channel educational media technology as a resource for effective learning.

LEEP recognizes that learners need to be 21st century-ready and holistically developed. LEEP follows the Knowledge Channel Constructivist Model that serves as a guide in ensuring that learners are given the chance to achieve authentic learning, to make meaning of their knowledge, and consequently to develop a passion for life-long learning.

The Knowledge Channel Teaching in the New Normal (KCTINN) is the online version of the LEEP. It covers topics that are relevant for teachers as they adapt their teaching strategies to the context of blended learning. Specifically, KCTINN 1, also called the Knowledge Channel Portable Media Library (KC PML) Tech Training, includes topics on the Learning Philosophy of KCFI, Using Technology as a Learning Resource and a walkthrough and orientation on the use of KCPML.
