**CONDUCT OF PROJECT HYBRID INTENSIVE TRAINING (Project HIT) FOR
TEACHERS AND LEARNERS IN ENGLISH JOURNALISM**

1. In adherence to Republic Act (RA) 7079 otherwise known as “Campus Journalism Act of 1991” and in support to DepEd MATATAG and “Bansang Makabata, Batang Makabansa”, this Office encourages all schools to promote the development and growth of campus journalism as a means of strengthening ethical values, encouraging critical and creative thinking and develop moral character and personal discipline of the Filipino youth in general, and of the Tagnipa Learners in particular. Consequently, the field is hereby informed of the conduct of Hybrid Intensive Training anchored on the theme: *Pahayagang Pangkampus: Kaagapay sa Paghilom at Pagbangon ng Sambayanan.*
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
 - b. sustain advocacy on social consciousness and environmental awareness;
 - c. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in journalism as a career or those who intend to use skill sets learned through campus journalism to give them a better edge in their chosen careers;
 - d. promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media; and
 - e. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.
3. Participants to this training are the advisers/teachers and campus journalists in English Journalism. Please see Enclosure 1 to this memorandum for the details of the training activities.
4. The participants are encouraged to observe health protocols such as physical distancing and the wearing of face masks at all times.
5. This Office shall adhere to Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in receiving the General Plan of Activities and attending to clarification/queries relative to the Conduct of Project Hybrid Intensive Training (HIT) for Teachers and Learners in English Journalism.
