**CORRIGENDUM TO DM NO. 243, s. 2023 RE: GOOD EDUCATION IN BEAUTIFUL "SAVIOR SCHOOLS (GEBSS) AND GOOD EDUCATION IN BEAUTIFUL "SAVIOR" CLASSROOMS (GEBSC)**

1. Regarding the issued **Division Memorandum No. 243, s. 2023 Re: Good Education in Beautiful "Savior Schools (GEBSS) and Good Education in Beautiful "Savior" Classroom (GEBSC)**, this office hereby directs the field to observe the changes of requirements on classroom structuring ( items 4 and 5) in compliance with DepEd Order No. 021, s. 2023 titled Guidelines on the Implementation of Brigada Eskwela 2023 specifically paragraph no. 2 (Maintenance of Clean Schools) during the implementation stage of Brigada Eskwela;

*"Schools shall ensure that school grounds, classrooms and all its walls, and other school facilities are clean and free from unnecessary artwork, decorations, tarpaulin, and posters at all times. Oversized signages with commercial advertisements, words of sponsorships, and/or endorsements or announcements of any kind or nature shall be taken down in compliance with DO 37, s. 2010 titled Prohibition on Use and/ or Display of School Signages Showing Commercial Advertisements, Sponsorships, and/or Endorsements. Classroom walls shall remain bare and devoid of posters, decorations, or other posted materials. Classrooms should not be used to stockpile materials and should be clear of other unused items or items for disposal".*

2. It is hereby advised that;
  - a. At the entrance of the room, a signboard is posted showing the following identification: Grade/Year and Section occupying the room, and Name of teacher handling the class.





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- b. A framed copy of the class program shall be displayed at the door at adult eye level.
  - c. Hotline Numbers shall be posted outside.
  - d. At the front wall (that is, the wall facing the class), the chalkboards must be properly framed and provided with a chalk ledge, installed at a height that is in accordance with the maximum comfortable reach of the children to the top of the board.
  - e. The teacher's table and cabinet shall be located at the rear of the classroom.
  - f. No posters shall be posted on classroom walls and shall remain bare and clean.
  - g. The seating arrangement of the pupils/students shall be flexible, depending upon the needs or activities of the class.
  - h. The classroom-based data on the Basic Education Information System (EBEIS) and other school forms shall be placed in a document filer.
  - i. No other corners of the classroom shall be used for the Reading Corner, NDEP Corner, and other related nooks.
  - j. The first aid or medicine cabinet, soap dish, towel rack, handwashing, and drinking facilities shall be installed in the health corner near the genderized comfort room.
3. Moreover, this office adheres to the Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP). Hence, all actions shall be based solely on the guidelines set with no discrimination on the account of age, gender, identity, sexual orientation, civil status, disability, religion, ethnicity, or political affiliation.
