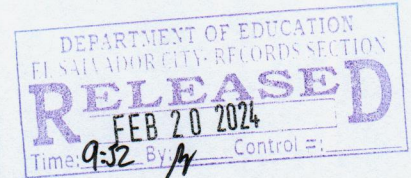

Special Note: For those girls/titas who have an international costume (any) please wear it.


May we also request that teachers participating in this event be given 1 day service credit.
