- 5. The participants shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No, 52 s. 2003 entitled *Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation service Credits to Teachers*. However, non-teaching personnel shall be given *Compensatory Time-Off (CTO)* per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2 s. 2004 on *Non Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered*, specific attention on Section 5.
- 6. This Office shall adhere to Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in the steps undertaken for this purpose. Hence, all decisions and actions shall be based on guidelines set forth, with no discrimination on the account of age, gender, identity, sexual orientation, civil status, disability, religion, ethnicity or political affiliation.


