

- 1. This Office informs the field of the conduct of the Division Training of Trainers on the ABC+ Instructional Leadership Training: Strengthening Learning Conditions for Early Literacy on **July 15-19, 2024**; venue of the aforesaid activity shall be announced in a separate memorandum.
- 2. This training program, Instructional Leadership Training: Strengthening Learning Conditions for Early Literacy (ILT) aims to:
 - a. support teachers in the actual application of literacy strategies, use of supplementary reading materials, and leading and facilitating LAC sessions;
 - b. build understanding of school's ability to better align instructions across grade levels (Kindergarten through Grade 3) through a cohesive, developmentally appropriate instruction that is integrated across subjects;
 - c. establish a school culture and climate that fully integrates SEL, fosters GESI, and promotes well-being inside and outside of the classroom;
 - d. (foster reflective, evidence-based practices by measuring teachers' skills and learners' learning outcomes using periodic, short, and quick tools such as classroom observation and formative assessment.
- 3. Participants of this training shall receive **15 CPD units** from the Professional Regulations Commission (PRC) upon completion of all the outputs and requirements needed.
