

## DIVISION MASS TRAINING OF TEACHERS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MATATAG CURRICULUM

- In preparation for the implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum for SY 2024-2025, this Office announces the conduct of the Division Mass Training of Teachers on the Implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum on July 23-27, 2024, at El Salvador City Central School, Poblacion, El Salvador City.
- 2. The MATATAG Curriculum training focuses on providing professional development support for teachers ensuring that they have an in-depth understanding of the general shape of the MATATAG Curriculum. Specifically, this activity aims to equip Kindergarten, Grade 1, Grade 4, and Grade 7 teachers with necessary knowledge, skills, and competencies to implement the new curriculum effectively.
- The participants' meals and supplies shall be charged against the 2024 HRD Funds allotted for the MATATAG Curriculum training while travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local/school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures. The first meal will be morning snacks on July 23 while the last meal will be afternoon snacks on July 27.
- Teacher-participants will be granted service credits per DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2023 titled Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers and DepEd Order No. 05, s. 2024 item A.4.4 on Teaching related assignments.
