

- c. collaborate among teachers and supervisors to incorporate the manual into teaching practices.
- 4. The participants' travel expenses shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations while the morning snacks, lunch, and afternoon snacks will be provided by PhilHealth.
