BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES (BSP) ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP AND WEARING OF SCOUTS UNIFORM

1. In consonance with **DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012** entitled **Guidelines on Revitalizing Boy Scouting in Schools Nationwide**, this Office hereby encourage all learners and personnel to be an active member of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) and to wear the scout uniform/neckerchief during official activities of the BSP and every Friday during school days for visibility and image building.
2. Membership to the BSP is voluntary and shall not be made a condition for enrolment, transfer or clearance of pupils and students. Membership fees and proceeds of fund-raising activities of the BSP shall be immediately remitted in full to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines Local Councils duly characterized by the National Office. No quota on membership shall be required.

The authorized membership fees for learners and adults are as follows:	
• Scouts	₱ 50.00
• Unit Leaders	₱ 60.00
• Institutional Representatives/Coordinators	₱ 100.00
• Committee Members	

3. If the learner cannot wear the prescribed Type A or B uniform because of its prohibitive cost, wearing of BSP Neckerchief will do.


