- 3. Each participant will be charged Php 650.00 for BTC and Php 750.00 for CLTC to cover the cost of their membership registration to the BSP Council, Certificate, training materials and other operational expenses.
- 4. In consideration of the DepEd policy on "No disruption of Classes", the Training Courses will commence on a Friday at 6:00PM and will end on a Sunday 1:00PM.
- 5. Teaching and non-teaching participants involved in the conduct of this activity during the weekend and/or holidays shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 52, s. 2003 entitled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. On the other hand, non-teaching staff shall be provided with Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission and Department of Budget ang Management Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.
- 6. This activity shall adhere to Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in the conduct of this activity. Hence, all decisions and actions shall be based solely on the guidelines set forth, with no discrimination on the account of age, ethnicity, gender, marital status, religion and political affiliation.
