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

However, non-teaching personnel shall be given Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2 s. 2004 on Non Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered, specific attention on Section 5.



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
