- 1. In line with our commitment of preparing students for the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) and enhancing the quality of education in the Division of El Salvador City, this Office organizes the Technical Working Group (TWG) in the division and field offices. - Conduct orientations and counseling to help students understand the relevance and goals of PISA.
 - Support students' emotional and mental readiness for the assessment.

Overall Responsibilities of the TWG

- 1. TWG members are to collaborate closely with respective school and SDO representatives to ensure all preparations meet PISA standards.
- Regular assessments, mock tests, and feedback sessions should be conducted to ensure that both teachers and students are adequately prepared.
- 3. Each TWG level shall submit progress reports or accomplishment reports detailing preparation milestones and any support needed.
- 4. Coordinate with all relevant stakeholders, including school heads and teachers for orientation and training sessions related to PISA.
- 5. Oversee the collection and submission of necessary documents and reports required for PISA administration.
- 6. Conduct regular meetings to assess progress and address any challenges encountered.
- 3. This Office shall adhere to Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in the steps undertaken for this purpose. Hence, all decisions and actions shall be based on guidelines set forth, with no discrimination on the account of age, gender, identity, sexual orientation, civil status, disability, religion, ethnicity or political affiliation.
- 4. This Office directs the immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum.
