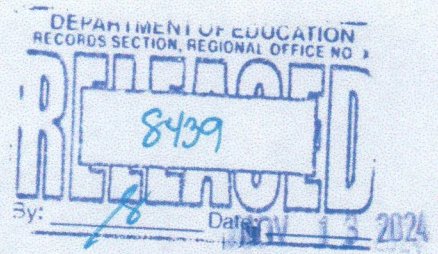

ADDENDUM TO THE PASIDUNGOG SA AMIHANANG MINDANAO (PAM)
2024 GUIDELINES

1. Regarding **Regional Memorandum No. 0636, s. 2024**, titled **2024 Pasidungog sa Amihanang Mindanao (PAM 2024)**, the Department of Education (DepEd) Region X proudly announces the inclusion of **PRAISE display**, **PAM Duet**, and **PAM Dance** competitions during the awarding ceremonies at Marco Hotel, Alwana Business Park, Cugman, Cagayan de Oro City, on December 2, with the theme "BigaTEN PAM: Purpose, Achievement, Momentum."
2. For the PRAISE display, each SDO is required to showcase the milestones of its PRAISE implementation over the years, including notable practices, accomplishments, and strong stakeholder support. The display specifications are as follows: half the size of a marine plywood board, in portrait orientation, with a thickness of $\frac{3}{4}$ inch and dimensions of 2 feet by 8 feet.
3. This display will be designed accordingly, using tarpaulins or other artistic styles, and installed at the venue on the scheduled date, one day before the event, in close coordination with the Regional Office (RO) personnel in charge of PAM for further instructions.
4. The PAM Duet competition involves pairs of DepEd employees from the 14 SDOs performing English or Tagalog songs with a focus on harmony, blending, and expressive interpretation, including facial expressions. The participants are required to use recorded music as their accompaniment, ensuring that the tracks are clear and properly aligned with their performance to highlight their vocal synchronization and stage presence.
5. The PAM Dance competition features pairs of dancers performing Latin styles such as Samba, Cha-Cha, Jive, and Rumba, emphasizing rhythm, technique, synchronization, and expressive movement. The participants must wear costumes that suit the style and culture of the dance, ensuring fluid movement and enhancing the performance. Recorded music will be used as accompaniment, with clear and properly aligned tracks to support the choreography.

6. All participants are expected to wear traditional Filipino attire—Barong Tagalog for men and Filipiniana dresses for women—to honor Filipino heritage and the formal nature of the event.
7. This office directs the immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum.
