Pursuant to Republic Act No. 8491, known as the "Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines," and the Civil Service Commission Memorandum Circular No. 19, s. 2012 on "Observance of Flag Ceremonies," ALL officials and employees are enjoined to attend the flag raising ceremony every Monday morning, or the next working day if Monday is declared a holiday. Existing workarrangements are deemed suspended during flag raising ceremonies. Employees recorded to be consistently absent in the Flag Raising Ceremonies, without any justifiable reason, shall be liable for violation of reasonable office rules and regulations, details to wit:

or at least two (2) consecutive months during the year	3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense	Dismissal from the service

- 2. Schedule of Flag Raising Ceremonies/ Monday Convocation for CY 2024 and the corresponding values focused for each week (Weekly Values focus are aligned with Civil Service Commission's "Patriotism, Integrity, Excellence, and Spirituality (PIES)" sequence) are attached herewith.
- 3. Schools are enjoined to establish internal guidelines to monitor the attendance of their personnel during flag ceremonies and ensure strict compliance, and shall submit a report to the Division Office through the personnel unit. Section Heads in the Division Office shall coordinate with the records officer for the monitoring of their personnel.
- Absence from the Flag Ceremony due to Official Business (OB) or Leave of 4. Absence/Sick Leave shall not be counted relative to the determination of habitual absence defined in this memorandum provided that a copy of duly approved document (Memo, AT, LS, etc..) is presented.

Employees are likewise reminded of our uniform policy in the Office: 5.

Working Days	Official Attire
Monday	Type A/ Agency-prescribed uniform for the day + Agency-prescribed ID
	Note: ASEAN-inspired/ Filipiniana-inspired will be worn during identified special events and all Mondays for the month of August.
Tuesday to Thursday	Type A/ Agency-prescribed uniform + Agency-prescribed ID
Friday	Smart Casual as defined under Section IV (H) and illustrated in Section V (A.4) + Agency-prescribed ID

- 6. Employees are prohibited from wearing the following during official functions, whether on-site or virtual:
  - a. collarless t-shirts, plunging necklines, sleeveless tops, sando/tank tops, tube tops, halters, strapless or spaghetti-strap blouses (unless as undershirts);
  - b. leggings, above-the-knee skirts, shorts, cycling or jogging pants (except during physical activities), ripped jeans;
  - c. sandals, slippers, or exposed-toe shoes, and excessive jewelry or heavy makeup, among others.


