LET'S SING FOR GOD

In reference to the Regional Advisory No. 2, s. 2025, this Office encourages all elementary schools to participate in the gospel song rendition "Let's Sing for God".

This activity is organized by The Hope Channel South Philippines (HCSP) in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd) Region X. It aims to nurture a spirit of reverence and devotion of being "Maka-Diyos" as learners perform praise songs that exalt God as the creator and protector.

The elementary schools may select one student who excels in singing gospel songs and submit a video of their candidate's performance. The video should be clear and of high quality, focusing on the student's vocal talent and stage presence. Videos should be no longer than five minutes and must be submitted by January 28, 2025 thru https://tinyurl.com/Sing-for-God.

Participation in this activity shall be on voluntary basis and shall be subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2025 titled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance therewith*, Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546 (Policy on Contributions), and DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 (Policy on Off-Campus Activities).

MECHANICS

Event Overview:

"Let's Sing for God" is a unique event that invites each school within your jurisdiction to select one student who excels in singing gospel songs to represent their institution. This event will officially kick off on February 1, with a special launching day where these talented students will perform live, representing their respective schools with pride and spirit.

I. Pre-Launching Activities: Period- From January 18-25, 2025

A. Audition Process:

To ensure a fair and inspiring selection for the "Let's Sing for God" event, we have designed a straightforward and accessible audition process. This process aims to discover talented young singers and provides a platform for them to showcase their skills in a supportive environment.

B. Submission Guidelines:

Eligibility: Each Elementary School within the Divisions of Cagayan de Oro, El Salvador, Misamis Oriental, and Gingoog is invited to select one student to represent their institution. The student must be capable of confidently and clearly performing a gospel song.

- C. Song Choice: Students may perform a gospel song in English, Tagalog, or Bisaya. The choice of music should reflect their vocal range and ability to convey the song's spiritual message.
- D. Video Submission: Schools must submit a video of their candidate's performance. The video should be clear and quality, focusing on the student's vocal talent and stage presence. Videos should be no longer than five minutes and must be submitted by January 28, 2025. I Hope Channel South Philippines will send a Gdrive link so all videos will be placed in the link with the school's name and the student's name as the file name. **Example: Balingasag Central School- Angel Faith Lagan.**

E. Selection Process:

- 1. Review and Feedback: Hope Channel South Philippines panel will review all video submissions. Each school will receive feedback on its submission, highlighting its strengths and areas for performance improvement.
- 2. Finalist Selection: Only 16 students from the video submissions will be

selected to perform at the official launching event on February 1. These finalists will be chosen based on their vocal ability, expression, and overall performance quality.

3. Final Performance Preparation: Hope Channel South Philippines will provide the final 16 students with the specific gospel songs they will perform at the launch. This will ensure that all performances are well-prepared and of high quality, reflecting the mission of HCSP and the event's spirit.

II. Launching - February 1, 2025, at Hope Channel South Philippines' studio

A. Rehearsals:

Finalists will be able to rehearse their songs with professional guidance from HCSP to prepare them for the live performance on February 1, 2025, from 10 AM to 2:00 PM.

B. Signing of Paperwork:

At 3:00 PM on February 1, at the studio, parents and teachers will sign the terms of an agreement between Hope Channel South Philippines to allow their minor student/child to be seen live and their recorded performance to be posted on social media and other platforms. This will be a chance for the teachers and parents to understand the mechanics of this activity.

C. From 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM on February 1, all 16 finalists will perform their assigned gospel song and be interviewed by the hosts. This will be live streamed via HCSP's official Facebook and YouTube pages.

III. Post-Launch Activities:

Following the launch, individual performance videos of these students will be uploaded to our online platforms. The aim is to engage the community by encouraging them to support their favorite performers through views, reactions, shares, and comments. This interactive component is designed to boost the visibility of talents and integrate educational activities with digital engagement, appealing to a broader audience.

A. Promotion: From February 8 to March 15, two participants will be featured on Panimbaya sa Kabuntagon World, a Saturday morning program of HCSP that airs from 6:00 to 7:30 AM on GSAT Channel 37 Nationwide and on Facebook and YouTube official pages. This will give

the kids and their parents time to highlight their stories and talents, building anticipation and support for their upcoming performances.

IV. Finals

The culmination of our event will take place on March 29 at 7:00 PM, where the 16 talented students will be honored with special awards during the final night of the celebration. We will be giving three major awards base on the following:

Views- 50% Reactions-30% Shares-10% Engagement-10%

A. Rewards

Voice Choice Award (Most Viewed Award):

The student whose performance video has the highest number of views will receive this special award and a gift to the school where a student represented a Home Economics Kitchen Set worth 30,000.00.

Audience Favorite Award (Most Reacted video)

The student whose performance video has the highest number of views will receive this special award and a gift to the school where a student represented a Sound System Set worth 20,000.00.

B. Trending Talent Award – (Most Shared Video)

The student whose performance video has the highest number of views will receive this special award and a gift to the school where a student represented a set of Monoblocks for seminars worth 10,000.00.

All 16 participants will receive a token of 3,000.00 for the travel expenses.

Ownership:

Following the event's conclusion on March 29th, all video and audio recordings of the 16 students' performances will become the property of Hope Channel South Philippines. However, the schools and the students will retain the right to share and receive a digital copy of their performances, which they may also post on their accounts.
