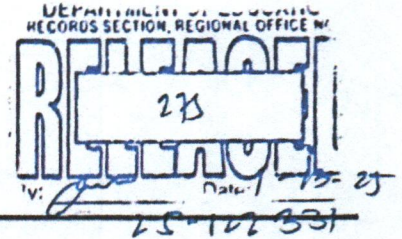



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

In line with the Department of Education's (DepEd) mission to foster holistic learner development, the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Sports Division (BLSS-SSD) is dedicated to enhancing this agenda through sports and physical activities. In addition, this training will impart best practices, techniques, and values across various sports, thereby empowering participants with confidence and competence needed to lead and support capacity building efforts among other sports stakeholders. These sessions will underscore the importance of sports in addressing the developmental needs of learners, facilitating their engagement in physical activities to promote health and growth.

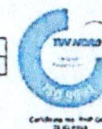
